## Introduction

### The Research group CRIT

The research group on Creativity, Innovation and Urban Transformation (CRIT) was founded in 2009, when different researchers from the Faculty of Economy and Business merged our efforts in Urban studies into a single research group.

At that moment we had already strong interrelation between us through the collaboration in European projects, including the European projects KATARSIS, SOCIAL POLIS and ACRE, where some of us analysed Housing systems, economic growth patterns, social inequalities and social innovation.

During these years, CRIT has established itself as a

consolidated group of the University of Barcelona with a recognised research path in local and international projects and collaborating with public and private agents.

The group is characterised by a commitment to interdisciplinarity. In the group there are sociologists, economists, anthropologists and philosophers, which allows to develop a complex view that enriches the approach in urban research.

The following pages will present the work carried out by the members of the group in 2018. The production this year has been very positive, and the national and international activity has

turned the year 2018 into a very positive year for the group.

In addition, in 2018 the group published the book *The moment of citizenship: social innovation and urban governance* with collaborations of several members. Some presentations of the book were made, obtaining a very good reception.

Finally, in 2018 some research projects were completed in which the CRIT was part as leaders and others in which it participated as members. The CICERONE project was also achieved in 2018, an important European project that will start in 2019.

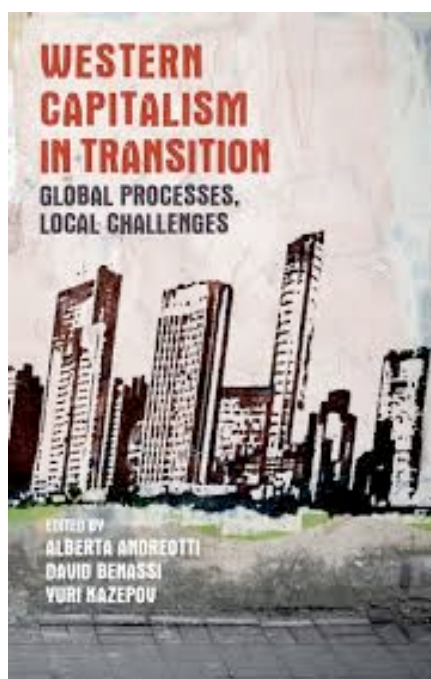

Previous analyses have mapped the location and distribution of the CCIs; CICERONE innovates by exploring the flows of products and ideas that generate the economic and cultural values in and of places, and which also account for the disparities between them. Moreover, CICERONE explores the evolving relationships between cultural and the economy. Place is central to this project; place as co-produced by networks: jobs, ideas, cultures and economies all come together in unique combinations in places, this is what makes them 'unique'. The variations in local capacities to respond to global forces determine the past, present and future of all territories. By using the global production network (GPN) approach we develop a comprehensive understanding of CCIs (in the form of industries, clusters and networks). Furthermore, CICERONE will translate this new

research into a stakeholder network, and an observatory, whose designs are reflective of the network approach. The purpose of this coordinated project is to define, based on the specificities of the creative, cultural and knowledge sectors, measures, actions or programs of public policy to encourage and strengthen them as well as the enhancement of the territory in which they develop .

As we researched in the project INNRED, cultural, creative and knowledge industries are in the embryonic development of new forms of production based on knowledge transfer networks and are less hierarchical than traditional industries organizational formulas. As creativity can only be understood looking at the interaction of individuals with social and contextual factors (Csikszentmihalyi, 1999). Therefore, certain environments facilitate interaction and provide more excitement and increased effervescence of ideas (Florida, 2002). Collaboration and interaction

between the players can follow different patterns (Grabher, 2004), but in all cases a growing phenomenon of disintermediation is easily noticeable. Creative spaces are linked to concepts such as collaboration, participation, cooperation, co-creation, open innovation, co-design, co-working ... Currently, recurrent vocabulary terms of the company, management or other social agents. On the other hand, as is already evident in the results of the INNOVA project,

the creative space has to take root in a community or region and become part of this identity and giving true value to a "creative space".

Under the framework defined by the coordinated project CREAPOL (New rationale for public / collective action to promote creativity, innovation and culture in the territory), CREASPACE aims to focus on 'spaces for creation', broadly defined and including different types: formal (university) and informal (communities of practice), public (factories of creation) or private (makers), ephemeral (festivals) or permanent (co-working spaces) monosectorial or transversal, traditional (R & D) and emerging (online support pages).

The main objective of this project is to answer the following question: up to what extent do new spaces for creation constitute a feasible and sustainable alternative for the emergence of creativity and innovation to existing spaces? This question is subdivided into others: what are the differences and similarities between spaces (business models, objectives, activities, actors...)?; What are the key variables for success?; What is the role of "creative space" in the worker trajectory? Do creative spaces that generate innovation, knowledge and creativity contribute to create competitive advantages in the economy by promoting its internationalization? Finally, following the path of CREAURBS and INNRED project, CREASPACE want to focus on the role of the territory through the study of creative spaces in Madrid, Barcelona, Bilbao and Valencia.

Manuel Castells (1996) argued over twenty years ago that the network society is 'space of flows', exemplified by online connectivity. The 'affordances' – potentials, opportunities – of the internet are crucial to the contemporary social practices of youth, including the constitution of gangs. Moreover, gangs have specific cultural practices and creative outputs. These too require recognition. In short, we need new ways of talking about transnational youth gangs in the global era. This project sets out to fill the gap.
